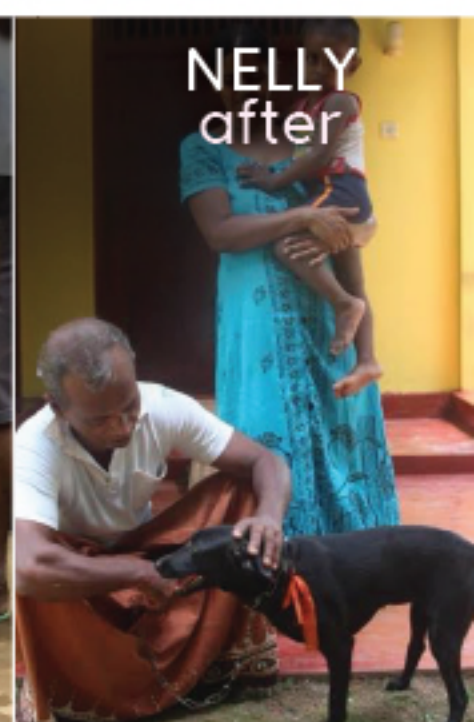

New Home for NELLY

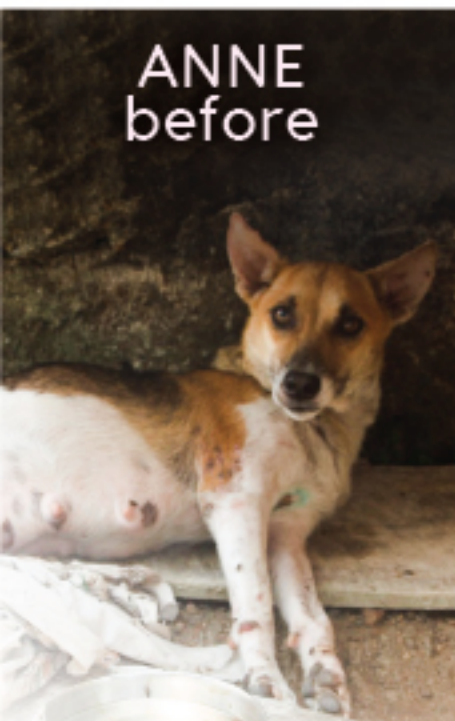
