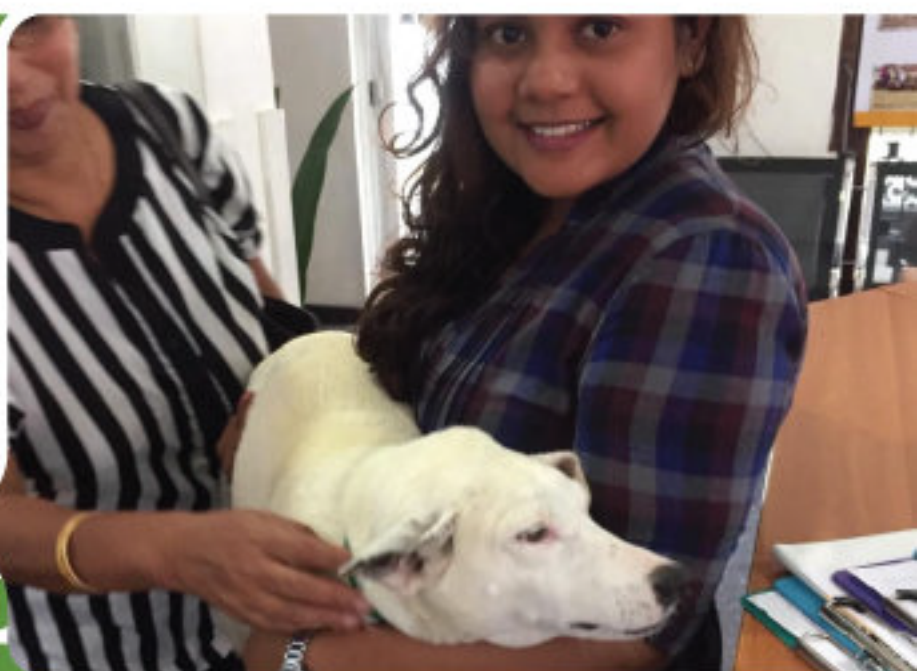

Project Anuradhapura phase 2 was conducted by Embark to sterilize, vaccinate and treat street and owned dogs in Anuradhapura. Phase two was a 10 day programme which successfully concluded with a total of 406 vaccinations, 348 sterilizations 228 treatments. It was yet again supported by Foundation Brigitte Bardot, Paris and the veterinary work was carried out by TAPA Sri Lanka.
